Describe first aid for those, plus shock and heatstroke. Describe how to apply bandages for a sprained ankle, and injured collarbone. Explain the steps of CPR.	_____
c. Navigation	Explain what you do if you get lost on a hike or campout, describe how a compass works	Use a compass to orient a map, know map symbols, tell how to find direction without a compass.	_____
d. Tools	Explain proper safety rules when using a pocket knife, saw and ax. Explain safety rules relating to building and extinguishing a fire.	Items in <i>Below First Class</i> , and explain three different ways to build a fire, and the proper way to extinguish a fire. Earn your Totem' Chip and your Fireman Chit.	_____
